The Department of Agriculture is currently recruiting to fill the following permanent position:

**Agricultural Marketing Director** is responsible for administering a comprehensive statewide program relating to agricultural products including inspection and grading services and promotion of use of agricultural products. Work involves directing programs and initiatives of the Bureau of Market Development; directing a professional staff that deals with the inspection and certification of a variety of farm products; developing strategies for addressing opportunities and challenges that face the agriculture industry; developing programs for the consumption of state agricultural products; evaluating effectiveness in the Bureau and bringing recommendations to the Deputy Secretary; planning, executing, and reconciling the budget of the Bureau, and operating the Bureau within financial allocations; and building consensus among internal and external stakeholders to achieve key initiatives of the administration.

- Minimum experience requirements are ten years of experience in agricultural marketing work including five years in a supervisory or administrative capacity; and such training as may have been gained through graduation from a four year college or university with major course work in agriculture or marketing; or any equivalent combination of experience and training.
- Salary range \$66,973 to \$101,829 commensurate with experience.
- This is a Senior Management Service (SMS) at-will position – a non-civil service management position with broad policy participating and management responsibility.
- This position is located at the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture headquarters in Harrisburg, PA (Dauphin Co.).
