## Overview

The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture Act 225 of 1982, as amended by Act 119 of 2008, is charged with enforcing the commonwealth’s Dog Law.

The Dog Law Enforcement Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture enforces laws and regulations, including licensing of individual dogs, licensing and inspection of kennels, activities related to dogs that are found running at large or classified as dangerous, and processing claims for livestock damage caused by dogs and coyotes.

As required by Section 906 of the Dog Law, this report to the General Assembly provides:

## **Dog Licenses**

Individual dog licenses in Pennsylvania are sold to dog owners through their county treasurers. Revenues from the sale of annual and lifetime licenses are directed to the Dog Law Restricted Account. Philadelphia County and the cities of Altoona, Erie, Harrisburg, Pittsburgh and Scranton maintain local dog licensing programs and retain licensing revenues generated. This report does not include sales or revenue generated within those cities.

In 2012, there were 846,323 individual dog licenses sold, including 808,776 annual and 37,547 lifetime licenses, generating \$5,262,479 in revenue (Appendix C).

## **Kennel Licenses**

The Dog Law Enforcement Office licensed 2,161 kennels in Pennsylvania in 2012, producing \$392,075 in license fees directed to the office's restricted account (Appendix D).

## **Out-of-State Dealers**

In 2012, 94 out-of-state dealers were licensed, generating \$14,750 in revenue for the restricted account (Appendix E).

## **Dog Law Inspection and Enforcement Activities**

A total of 4,711 kennel inspections were completed in 2012 (Appendix F). All kennels were inspected twice.

## **Citation Issuance**

The Dog Law Enforcement Office refused five kennel license applications and revoked one kennel license in 2012.

In 2012, 3,113 summary citations and 56 misdemeanor charges were issued. These numbers include citations related to kennel inspections and other violations of the Dog Law, including but not limited to failure to license, dogs running at large or abandoned and dangerous dogs (Appendix H).

## **Dogs Seized and Impounded and Total Reimbursements**

The Dog Law Enforcement Office plays a critical role in managing stray dogs by assisting with capturing and transporting dogs to shelters. In addition, during 2012 shelters and municipalities received payments from the restricted account for

reimbursement of costs related to transportation, feeding and care of stray dogs. A total of \$240,420 was paid for 9,086 dogs statewide (Appendix I).

## **Payments Made from the Dog Law Restricted Account**

All revenue and expenses related to the Dog Law Enforcement Office are credited and disbursed from the Dog Law Restricted Account, as required by Section 1001 of the Dog Law. No dollars from the general fund are directed to the account.

## **Licensing Fees**

The primary source of revenue is the sale of individual dog licenses, supplemented by kennel licenses, and fines capped at approximately \$70,000 annually. For 2012, approximately \$5.26 million was generated by the sale of individual dog licenses.

## **Accomplishments**

The focus of the Dog Law Enforcement Office in 2012 was to continue to restore the solvency of the Dog Law Restricted Account through advances in the following areas:

### **Operations:**

- The office drafted a standard operating procedure manual for the first time. Staff and dog wardens received training on the manual, which outlines functions of the office, including a warden's daily duties, forms used to carry out these duties, policies and procedures and copies of all applicable regulations and laws.
- Added four additional wardens to improve operations across the state, bringing the total to 49 wardens and seven supervisors.
- Regions of the state were redrawn so that dog wardens can more easily travel to canvass and perform inspections.

### **Training:**

The office purchased kestrels for commercial kennels. These devices are used to take an immediate reading of temperature, humidity, heat stress index, and wind

speed. These readings can be saved as evidence when needed to prosecute kennel owners who are not maintaining a safe and healthy environment for dogs. Dog wardens received training on the proper use of these instruments.

**Marketing and Public Relations:**


- Increased emphasis was placed on dog license sales, including a dog owner education campaign that included press releases, news articles, op-ed pieces, brochures and displays for use at fairs and events and public appearances.
- Dog wardens played a vital part in communicating the dog licensing message through public education at the Pennsylvania Farm Show, Penn State's Ag Progress Days and many local events throughout the state.
- To help dog owners understand Pennsylvania's dog laws, particularly those related to licensing, the office created [www.licenseyourdogPA.com](http://www.licenseyourdogPA.com).
- Social media was used to promote the sale of licenses and educate consumers about the importance of licensing dogs.

**Partnerships:**

- Partnerships were renewed with county treasurers to help them communicate to constituents the importance of licensing.
- Posters and flyers were created to promote dog license sales. A treasurer tool kit including a sample press release, op-ed, posters, and speaking points is available at [www.licenseyourdogPA.com](http://www.licenseyourdogPA.com).

Looking ahead to 2013, the focus of the Dog Law Enforcement Office continues to be the restoration of financial solvency to the Dog Law Restricted Account. The office must continue its regulatory duties to enforce the dog law and increase sales of dog licenses to meet this goal.
