## **Overview**

The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, through Act 225 of 1982, as amended by Act 119 of 2008, is charged with enforcing the commonwealth's Dog Law.

The Dog Law Enforcement Office (DLEO) under the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture enforces regulations, including licensing of individual dogs, licensing and inspection of kennels, activities related to dogs that are found running at large or classified as dangerous, and processing claims for livestock damage caused by dogs and coyotes.

As required by Section 906 of the Dog Law, this report to the General Assembly provides:

## **Dog Licenses**

Pennsylvania dog licenses are sold to dog owners by county treasurers. Revenues from the sale of annual and lifetime licenses are directed to the Dog Law Restricted Account. Philadelphia County and the cities of Altoona, Erie, Harrisburg, Pittsburgh and Scranton maintain local dog licensing programs and retain licensing revenues generated. This report does not include sales or revenue generated within those cities.

In 2013, there were 966,398 individual dog licenses sold, including 924,225 annual and 42,173 lifetime licenses, generating \$5,988,238 in revenue – Appendix C.

License sales increased by 14.2% from calendar year 2012 to 2013.

## **Kennel Licenses**

The Dog Law Enforcement Office licensed 2,177 kennels in Pennsylvania in 2013, garnering \$397,500 in license fees directed to the office's restricted account – Appendix D.

## **Out-of-State Dealers**

In 2013, 92 out-of-state dealers were licensed, generating \$13,550 in revenue for the restricted account – Appendix E.

## **Dog Law Inspections**

A total of 4,679 kennel inspections were completed in 2013 – Appendix F. All kennels were inspected twice as required by the Pennsylvania Dog Law.

## **Enforcement Activities**

The Dog Law Enforcement Office refused five kennel license applications and revoked three kennel licenses in 2013.

Forty-four individuals were cited for operating a kennel without a license and 1,129 citations were issued to owners who failed to license their dogs.

Sixteen notices of violations were issued to kennel operators and dangerous dog owners.

In 2013, DLEO collected \$57,550 in Dangerous Dog registration fees and \$30,000 in administrative penalties, settlements and restitution fees.

## **Citation Issuance**

In 2013, 4,077 summary citations and 70 misdemeanor charges were issued for kennel and other violations of the Dog Law, including but not limited to failure to license, dogs running at large or abandoned and dangerous dogs – Appendix H.

## **Dogs Seized and Impounded and Total Reimbursements**

The Dog Law Enforcement Office plays a critical role in managing stray dogs by assisting with capturing and transporting dogs to shelters. In addition, during 2013 shelters and municipalities received payments from the restricted account for reimbursement of costs related to transportation, feeding and care of stray dogs. A total of \$241,640 was paid for 7,379 dogs statewide – Appendix I.

DLEO discontinued its grant program for the 2013-2014 fiscal year; however, it increased the amount of money paid to shelters for holding and disposing to all licensed kennels that accept stray dogs. Holding and disposing fees were increased from \$25 to \$40 per dog. Currently 147 licensed kennels receive holding and disposing payments from DLEO.

## **Payments Made from the Dog Law Restricted Account**

All revenue and expenses related to the Dog Law Enforcement Office are credited and disbursed from the Dog Law Restricted Account, as required by Section 1001 of the Dog Law. No dollars from the general fund are directed to the account.

## Licensing Fees

The primary source of revenue for the Dog Law Restricted Account is the sale of individual dog licenses. This is supplemented by kennel licenses and fines that is capped at approximately \$70,000 annually. For 2013, approximately \$5.99 million was generated by the sale of individual dog licenses.

## Accomplishments

### Operations:

- Created a Standard Operating Procedure manual for dog wardens to use in daily operations.
- Developed a strategic plan outlining the office mission and goals.
- Hired two additional wardens to improve operations across the state. To date, there are 51 wardens, seven supervisors, and one kennel compliance specialist.

### Training:

- In 2013, wardens were trained on:
  - The proper use of bite sticks, pepper spray,
  - Case preparation and courtroom testimony,
  - Officer safety and basic self-defense,
  - Additional Kestrel training with manufacturer,
  - Veterinary training (basic information on what signs to look for illness and neglect in dogs).

### Marketing and Public Relations:

- Increased emphasis on dog license sales, including a dog owner education campaign including press releases, news articles, op-ed pieces, brochures and displays for use at fairs, events and public appearances.
- Governor Tom Corbett proclaimed March 2013 as Dog License Awareness Month. Agriculture Secretary George Greig, state dog wardens and pet specialty retailer PetSmart® challenged Pennsylvanians to license their dogs, setting a goal to sell 100,000 licenses as part of the initiative. The licensing

goal was met and PetSmart donated \$10,000 to the non-profit organization Susquehanna Service Dogs.

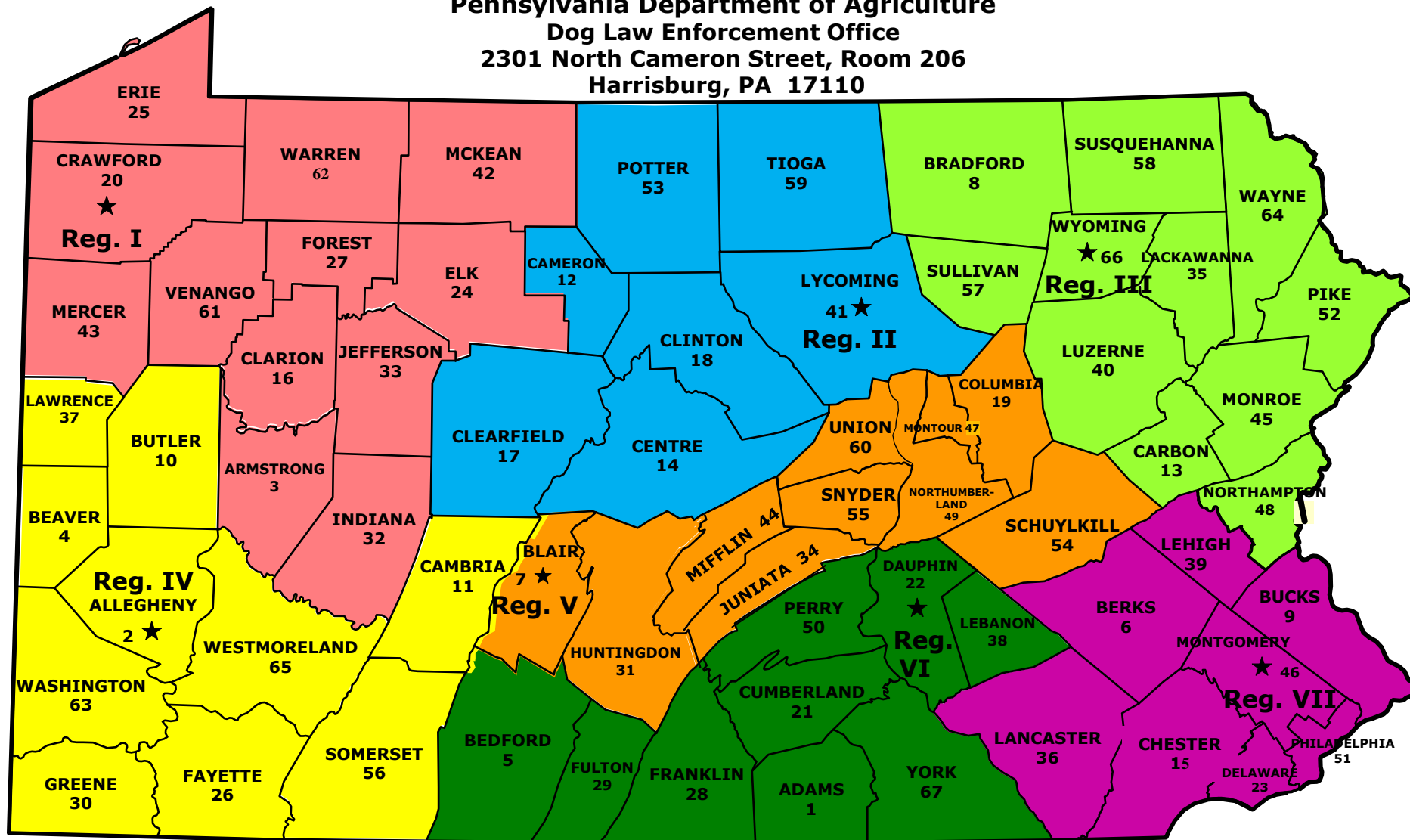
- Dog wardens communicated the dog licensing message through public education at the Pennsylvania Farm Show, Penn State's Ag Progress Days and local events throughout the state.
- Launched [www.licenseyourdogPA.com](http://www.licenseyourdogPA.com) to help dog owners understand Pennsylvania's dog laws, particularly those related to licensing.
- Used social media to promote the sale of licenses and educate consumers about the importance of licensing dogs.

**Partnerships:**

- Strengthened relationships were renewed with county treasurers to help them communicate to constituents the importance of licensing.
- Created posters and flyers to promote dog license sales. A treasurer and warden tool kit with a sample press release, op-ed, posters, and speaking points are available at [www.licenseyourdogPA.com](http://www.licenseyourdogPA.com).
- The Dog Law Enforcement Office continues to grow its partnerships with county treasurers, the General Assembly, township supervisors, the Pennsylvania Veterinary Medical Association, and shelters to bring awareness to the importance of dog licensing.

Looking ahead to 2014, the Dog Law Enforcement Office is committed to ensuring the financial solvency of the Dog Law Restricted Account. The office will continue its regulatory duties to enforce the Dog Law and increase sales of dog licenses to meet this goal.
