

GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING
THE SEMI-ANNUAL SOIL AND PLANT AMENDMENT TONNAGE REPORT

The Pennsylvania Soil and Plant Amendment Act requires each manufacturer to file a semiannual report of tonnage, by county, for each brand or grade of soil amendment and/or plant amendment sold in Pennsylvania for containers greater than **15** pounds.

The report must include all sales for the period January 1 to June 30 and July 1 to December 31 of each year, the amount of the inspection fee due, and any penalties if applicable.

1. DATE: Indicate the month, day, year the report is being prepared.
2. COUNTY: Name of county where soil amendment and/or plant amendment was sold.
3. SALES: Show sales to nearest ton.
4. CONTAINER: Check appropriate box(es).
5. USE: Check appropriate box(es).
6. CALCULATE the total amount due and make check(s) or money order(s) payable to:
There is NO CHARGE for ZERO TONNAGE.
