

Soil and Plant Amendments FAQs

Soil and Plant Amendments

- 1. Who is required to be licensed to sell and distribute soil and plant amendments?**
Pennsylvania manufacturers and all guarantors (the name and address that appears on the label of the product) are required to be licensed.
- 2. Do I need to be licensed to retail or wholesale someone else's soil and plant amendments?**
No. If you have manufacturer private label products with your name and address as the guarantor, then you would be required to be licensed.
- 3. Is there individual product registration for soil and plant amendments?**
Yes. Each brand and grade of soil and plant amendment requires registration.
- 4. Are there labeling requirements for soil and plant amendment?**
Yes. All soil and plant amendments have specific labeling requirements. In addition, product claims made in labeling (including literature and brochures distributed with the product) may require substantiation from an approved institution. You can contact your nearest Regional Office or the Harrisburg Office for more information or read the Instructions for Licensing under the Pennsylvania Soil and Plant Amendment Act.
- 5. Who do I contact if I have a question or a consumer complaint concerning soil and plant amendments?** You should contact the nearest Regional Office or the Program Coordinator.
