

**PENNSYLVANIA STATE HORSE RACING COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING**

April 21, 2014

A meeting of the Pennsylvania State Horse Racing Commission was held at New Bolton Center in Moelis Conference Room on Monday, April 21, 2014, at 9:30 A.M. In attendance representing the Commission was Corinne Sweeney, Commissioner, Walter Remmert, Acting Executive Secretary of Horse Racing and by phone Alan Novak, Chairman, Jonathan Newman, Commissioner, Jorge Augusto, Legal Counsel.

Jorge Augusto, Legal Counsel, noted that the Commission did engage in a quasi-judicial Executive Session this morning and no other agency business was transacted.

Chairman Novak noted that the meeting had been advertised in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

Chairman Novak then brought the Samuel Webb adjudication to order.

Adjudication of Samuel E. Webb

AND NOW, this 21st day of April, 2014, upon consideration of the testimony and exhibits of record, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Appeal of Samuel E. Webb is **GRANTED**. The procedure applicable to Webb's case at the time of his suspension and subsequent hearing failed to provide him with the process to which he was due. Accordingly, the license of Samuel E. Webb must be reinstated immediately.

Chairman Novak asked for a motion, Commissioner Sweeney and Commissioner Newman seconded the motion. The motion carries and the order is approved by a 3-0 vote.
