Health Papers: Your local or state veterinarian should be able to update you concerning the health requirements for sheep entering your state. All sheep sold must be in compliance with current Federal Scrapie Regulations. The sale veterinarian will prepare standard, interstate health papers for transportation between states upon request, but it is the buyer's responsibility to be cognizant of and adhere to the entrance requirements of his own state. When entry permits are required, this can often be done prior to your arrival at the sale by contacting your state office. Your local veterinarian can often help facilitate this process.

Notice: Neither sale management, sale sponsors, nor consignors to the sale assume any risk or liability in case of accidents of any kind or losses of any kind to any person or persons in attendance at the sale.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Terms of the sale are cash or check. All checks must be made payable to Livestockbuyer.com. No sale animal may leave the premises until payment has been received.
2. Each sheep or goat will be sold to the highest bidder.
3. The auctioneer will settle any disputes regarding bids that may arise. This decision will be final.
4. Applicable Certificates of registry will be furnished and transferred to new ownership. Registration certificates for any progeny of these sires are dependent upon the breed association. (i.e. kids from percentage Boer bucks may not have the ability to be registered within certain breed associations).
5. All sheep and goats are at the seller's risk until sold and will be the buyer's risk as soon as sold.
6. Certificates of Veterinary Inspection will be furnished by the Livestock Evaluation Center/ Centre Herd Health Vet Services.
7. All sheep and goats are guaranteed breeders by the sellers, providing they are properly cared for and not exhibited on the show circuit prior to being used for breeding. In the event a sheep or goat is thought to be a non-breeder by the buyer, he may be returned to the seller at the buyer's expense within six months of the sale date. In the case of a sheep or goat claimed to be a non-breeder, the seller is entitled to the period of time, following return of the sheep or goat, required through the next regular breeding season, in which to demonstrate that the sheep or goat is a breeder. If in that time the sheep or goat proves a non-breeder, then refunding of the purchase price shall be considered full settlement. Other procedures for settlement may be taken if satisfactory to both the buyer and the seller.
8. The above guarantee and terms of the sale shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller for each sheep or goat sold and shall be equally binding upon both. The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, Pennsylvania State University, Pennsylvania Sheep and Wool Growers Association, Livestockbuyer.com or other sale management or any other person or organization connected with the management of the sale do not assume liability, legal or otherwise, except to help make any needed adjustments.
9. All persons attending the sale do so at their own risk. Neither the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, nor any other person or organization connected with the sale will assume liability, legal or otherwise, for the safety in the buildings, on the premises or in behavior of the animals.
