

GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING
THE SEMI-ANNUAL FERTILIZER TONNAGE REPORT

The Pennsylvania Fertilizer Act as amended requires each manufacturer to file a semi-annual report of tonnage, by county, for each brand or grade of fertilizer sold in Pennsylvania, for containers greater than 15 pounds, including bulk sales.

The statement must include all sales for the period January 1 to June 30 and July 1 to December 31 of each year, the amount of the inspection fee due, and any penalties, if applicable.

1. DATE: Indicate the month, day, year the report is being prepared.
2. COUNTY: Name of county where fertilizer was sold.
3. SALES: Show sales to nearest ton.
4. FERTILIZER CODE: Indicate the Fertilizer Code, if known.
5. CHEMICAL ANALYSIS: Indicate the chemical composition of mixes.
6. CONTAINER: Check one.
7. USE: Check one.
8. CALCULATE the total amount due and make check(s) or money orders(s) payable to:
(There is NO CHARGE for ZERO TONNAGE)
