



Transfer of PA ID Plates

Dear Pennsylvania Amusement Ride/Attraction Owner:

In order to transfer a PA ID plate and its registration from one owner to another, signatures from both owners must be signed below before the transfer can take place.

The issued plate is stamped with the PA ID number by the bureau and is to be permanently affixed to the ride or attraction. It is important to display the current Registration Plate with its current year sticker. Without the current plate, it appears to the public that your ride or attraction might not be registered or inspected and **may result in being shut down by the Quality Assurance Inspector**. The registration plate remains the property of the Department of Agriculture and is furnished to the owner at no cost (unless it is lost).

If a plate is lost, a replacement plate can be issued by mailing a check payable to The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania totaling the sum of \$30.00 for each replacement plate needed. (Attach the Replacement Plate Request form)
