Failure to comply with any requirements will subject you to a penalty as provided by law.

Data Plate and labeling requirements for Inflatables

There are two sections to this document that outline the requirements for identification of Amusement Rides and Inflatables. The first is from the Pennsylvania regulations and the second portion are ASTM requirements. Said identification follows through with accident reporting, registration, inspection and insurance. The information must permanently affixed to the equipment and remain consistent throughout. In Pennsylvania this identification also applies to approval for registration.

CHAPTER 139. AMUSEMENT RIDES AND ATTRACTIONS

(c) Identification and rating plates. Manufacturers' identification information affixed to the ride or attraction shall be maintained in a readily visible and legible condition at all times to the inspector.

6. Quality, Manufacture and Construction

6.1.2.2 Permanent Labeling:

(1) All of the information requirements in this section shall be permanently posted on the inflatable device and included in the documented operating instructions provided by the manufacturer in conformance with subsection 6.1.2 of Practice

F1193-18a.

(2) Information Plate—The following information shall be included on the information plate of the inflatable amusement device, with safety-related parameters specified in both Imperial and SI units (see Appendix X4). The information plate for an inflatable amusement device shall be composed of a material compatible with the device.

(a) Applicable requirements include at a minimum: Device Serial Number, Device Name and manufacturer, Device Model Number, Date of Manufacture, Patron Capacity by Number, and Recommended Patron Restrictions, including minimum and maximum patron height. (See Note 2.)

(b) Operator/Attendants—Minimum number of operator/ attendants required when the inflatable amusement device is in operation or occupied by patrons.

(c) Maximum Sustained Wind Speed—The inflatable device must be evacuated and deflated if the sustained wind speed reaches or exceeds this value during operation.

(d) Blower Requirements—The number of blowers required and specifications for each to include size or horsepower, minimum volume flow, and minimum static pressure.

(e) Anchoring Notice—A statement that the inflatable amusement device must be anchored and tethered in compliance with the instructions in the device manual whenever patrons are using the device, including both indoor and outdoor installations.

(f) The information plate shall state the inflatable amusement device was built in conformance with this standard practice.

NOTE 2—Appendix X4 outlines recommendations for applicable requirements.

(3) Safety Label—A manufacturer issued safety label shall be permanently affixed near the entrance to the device, listing safety-critical rules and restrictions that apply to each patron using the device. The use of additional directional safety label(s) with location-specific instructions, reminders or warnings for patrons, installers or operator/attendants shall be permitted.

(4) Manufacturers or suppliers of inflatable amusement devices must warn, through proper labeling, of potential identified hazards and risks of their products so that patrons can make informed decisions regarding use of the device if they choose not to follow given posted safety guidelines.
